

Notice to the Public and the Profession

The Tax Court of Canada is presently preparing for the reopening of several of its offices in the near future and for the resumption of in-person Court hearings in a number of cities across the country starting July 20th, 2020.

Parties whose hearings were interrupted in March by the closure of the Court or whose general appeals were adjourned in March and April can expect to be contacted in priority to schedule the continuation or hearing of their appeal.

The Court is also looking into conducting litigation process conferences, such as Case Management Conferences, Pre-trial Conferences and Status Hearings, by phone or online in the coming weeks.

The Registry offices across the country remain closed for the transaction of business until further notice.

Further information concerning the Court's return to regular operations, the suspension of timelines, the computation of time and other issues relevant to the resumption of Court operations and sittings will be posted on the Court's website in the coming days.
