Cancellation of Sittings

Due to the prevalence of COVID-19 in cities where the Tax Court of Canada is scheduled to hold proceedings, the Chief Justice has cancelled all in-person Court sittings scheduled between February 15, 2021 and March 12, 2021, inclusively.

Some conference calls scheduled to proceed between February 15, 2021 and March 12, 2021, inclusively, may also need to be cancelled.

Parties affected by the cancellation of in-person sittings or conference calls will be contacted directly by the Registry staff in the coming days.

The Chief Justice will continue to monitor the situation closely and will reassess the week of March 1st, 2021, whether the judicial sittings schedule will have to be further altered.

The Court and its Registry offices remain open, with the exception of the Hamilton office.
